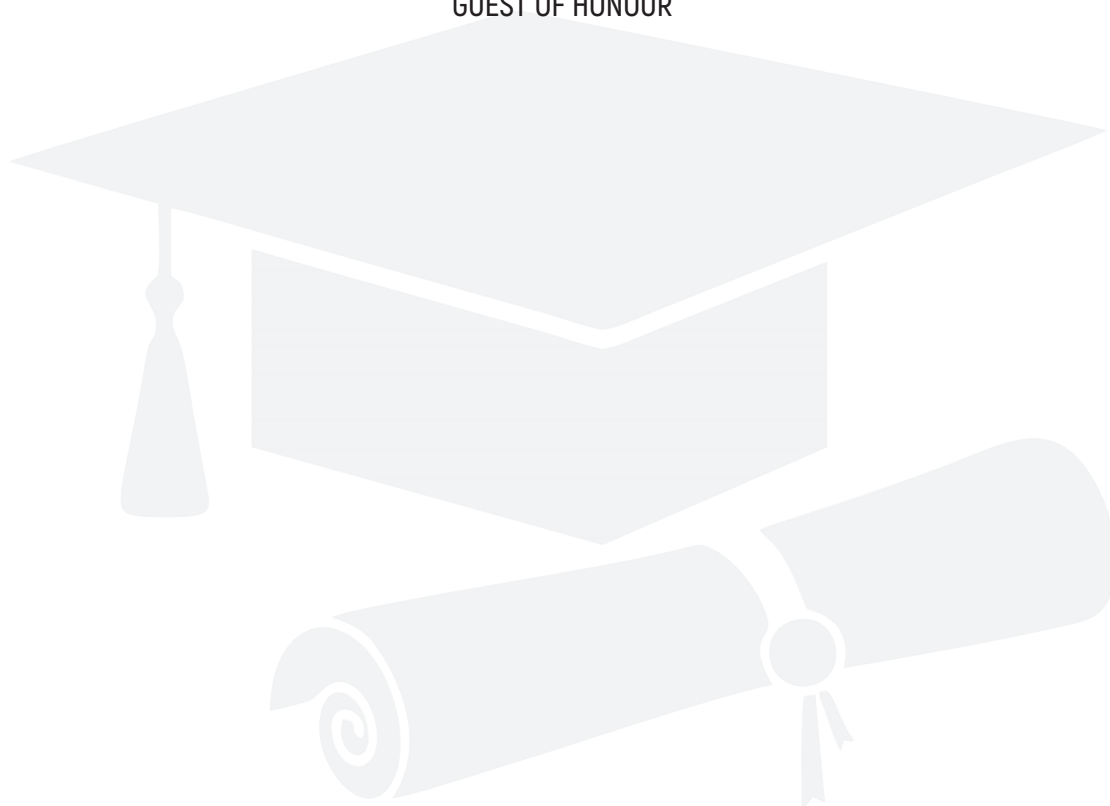

**Petan HAMAZAKAZA**

Msc [LUAS-WUR], BSc [UNZA]

**THESIS TITLE:** Mitigating agriculture expansion through Sustainable Agricultural Intensification: Impacts on natural resources and the environment in the Eastern Province of Zambia."

**P**etan Hamazakaza holds a BSc in Agricultural Economics from the University of Zambia and an MSc in Rural Development and Livelihoods from Larenstein University of Applied Sciences, part of Wageningen University and Research Centre (Netherlands). In 2024, he completed his PhD by Research at The Copperbelt University, School of Natural Resources, under the Doctoral Regional Research Grant of the Regional Universities Forum for Capacity Building in Agriculture (RUFORUM) scholarship. His doctoral research was supervised by Professor Gillian Kabwe (Main Supervisor, CBU) and Professor Elias Kuntashula (Co-supervisor, University of Zambia). He assessed the likelihood of the adoption of Sustainable Agricultural Intensification practices as a potential strategy for mitigating agriculture expansion and its impacts on forestry resources in Zambia. His research contributes to the debate on influences of natural resources, and environmental management actions and policy directions, besides serving as a reference for future research on natural resources conservation, particularly forests in the Eastern Province of Zambia and other regions that have similar farming systems. To ensure wider dissemination, the findings have been presented at national and international conferences with publications in scholarly open-access, reputable scientific journals.

The study was conducted in the Katete district of Zambia, which is predominantly rural, agriculturally dependent, and is among the most impacted districts in terms of agricultural expansion-related forest loss. The study classified and established the sustainable agricultural practices utilised among farmers to enhance productivity and their effect on agricultural land expansion. The study identified the key decision variables for adopting sustainable agricultural practices in mitigating agricultural expansion at the smallholder farm level. His research work highlights that the mitigation of agricultural productivity challenges through technology dissemination should be coupled with farmer education, strengthened social capital, and extension support. Furthermore, the study confirms the potential positive impact of sustainable agricultural technology adoption on reducing agricultural farmland expansion among smallholder farmers, which translates into increased conservation of natural resources, especially forests. His research work recommends the need to enhance the alignment of the implementation of agricultural extension to government policies to strengthen their operational capacity, as well as the overall literacy of farmers concerning sustainable agriculture as a package of working practices. His research output has been published in peer-reviewed journals.

### Thesis Abstract

A growing global population is exacerbating the need for more food and agricultural land. While expanding agricultural land into forests has significant environmental consequences, it has been seen as a necessary response to meeting the rising food demands. However, the current rate of cropland expansion is considered unsustainable and is at the expense of forest resource conservation and the

**THESIS TITLE:** Potential Aquatic Ecological Risks in Mining Landscapes of North-Western Zambia Copperbelt: Implications for Ecosystem Management.

**K**ennedy O. Ouma, holds a BSc in Fisheries and Aquatic Sciences (Moi University-Kenya), an MSc in Limnology (Egerton University-Kenya), and International Post-Graduate Diplomas in Limnology-IPGL of Rivers, Lakes, Wetlands, Fisheries and Aquaculture Systems (IHE-Delft, formerly UNESCO-IHE, The Netherlands). In 2024 Kennedy concluded his PhD by Research at The Copperbelt University, School of Natural Resources, under the World Bank ACE-II CBU-Africa Centre of Excellence (CBU-ACESM) and O. R. Tambo Africa Research Chairs Initiative (ORTARCHI) scholarships. He explored the aquatic ecological risks of metal pollution in river basins draining mining landscapes and the implications for sustainable aquatic ecosystem management. This was under the supervision of Prof. S. Syampungani (main supervisor) and Dr A. Shane (co-supervisor) of Copperbelt University. His research provides critical insights into environmental management, shaping policy directions and informing future research on aquatic ecosystem health in the North-Western Zambia Copperbelt and comparable ecoregions. The findings of this research have been presented at national and international conferences with publications in scholarly open-access scientific journals.

**Thesis Abstract**

Africa accounts for nearly 30% of the discovered world's mineral reserves, with 50% of the world's platinum group metals deposits, 36% of gold, and 20% of cobalt hosted in Southern Africa (SA). In recent years, mining pollution from industrial and artisanal mining has significantly affected the ecological integrity of SA aquatic ecosystems. Lotic ecosystems draining the SA mining landscapes, including the Central African Copperbelt (CACB), remain vulnerable to mining pollution, threatening the attainment of the

2030 UN SDG 6. In the rapidly transforming mining landscape in Zambia's "new" Copperbelt North-Western frontier, the ecological risks to its aquatic ecosystems from industrial and artisanal mining are inadvertent. Appropriate management interventions will require scientifically-backed evidence to ensure sustainable mining in the region. In this research, Kennedy aimed at developing an understanding of the potential ecological risks to stream ecosystems in North-Western Province, which is also a water tower for major rivers in the country. The study established the current ecological status of lotic systems as a baseline for present and future interventions, in the light of expanding mining and ore processing activities in the region. Further, an eco-friendly integrated ecological assessment approach to audit these vulnerable ecosystems was explored and successfully implemented with evidence of complementarity. Based on sedimentological and rapid bioassessment techniques, key findings indicated "low-to-moderate" ecotoxicity on stream sediments and "low" potential ecological risk to aquatic biota from the environmental impacts of mining within the north-western Zambia Copperbelt. With these promising insights, there is a need to institute regulatory and policy frameworks that will ensure a consistently healthy aquatic ecosystem in the north-western Zambia Copperbelt thereby providing the ecosystem services that support biodiversity and sustainable mining.





**Davies WAMBWA**

**THESIS TITLE:** Comparative Assessment of the Use of the Environmental Protection Fund for Sustainable Mining in Zambia.

**D**avies Wambwa holds a Bachelor of Development Studies from Uganda Christian University and a Master of Science in Environmental Engineering, Monitoring, and Management from The Copperbelt University (CBU), supported by the EU-AU-funded Intra-Africa Academic Mobility Scheme (AFIMEGQ). In 2021, he enrolled for his PhD by Research at CBU's School of Mines and Mineral Science, Department of Environmental Engineering, under the World Bank ACE II Copperbelt University Africa Centre of Excellence for Sustainable Mining. His research evaluated Zambia's Environmental Protection Fund (EPF) and its effectiveness in promoting responsible mine closure and environmental sustainability. As part of his doctoral studies, Davies studied at the University of Valladolid (Spain) in 2022 through the Erasmus+ Credit Mobility Fellowship, where he collaborated with the Atmospheric Optics Group on his research. His PhD thesis was supervised by Dr. J. Mundike (Main Supervisor) and Dr. B. Chirambo (Co-supervisor) at CBU. His research provides critical insights into the challenges and opportunities of financial assurance programs in mine closure across Africa and serves as a basis for reforms in environmental governance within Zambia's mining sector and also in sustainable mining policy and governance. He has received regional and international recognition, with publications in high-impact journals.

effectiveness of Zambia's Environmental Protection Fund (EPF) in facilitating sustainable mining practices. The research reveals systemic challenges including inadequate funding, complex legal frameworks, limited compliance by mining companies, and weak enforcement mechanisms. Comparative analysis of Konkola Copper Mines and Lubambe Copper Mines highlights moderate regulatory adherence but exposes weaknesses in EPF execution, such as lack of audit guidelines and difficulties in securing bank guarantees. The study recommends strengthening the legal and administrative frameworks, enhancing monitoring and enforcement, and increasing collaboration with international partners. These reforms are essential for ensuring the EPF effectively supports sustainable mining and mitigates the adverse environmental and social impacts of mining in Zambia.

### Thesis Abstract

Mining plays a pivotal role in Zambia's economic development but poses significant environmental risks, particularly during and after mining operations. Sustainable mine closure is vital for environmental protection, requiring early planning, funding, and regulatory oversight. This study evaluates the

**THESIS TITLE:** A Community-based Facilities Management Framework for the regeneration of former mine owned Recreation Centres in Copperbelt

**L**illas Makashini holds a BSc in Land Economy (Copperbelt University) and an MSc in Real Estate Studies (University of Pretoria). In 2024, Lillas completed her PhD by Research at The Copperbelt University, School of the Built Environment, under the World Bank ACE-II CBU Africa Centre of Excellence for Sustainable Mining (CBU-ACESM) scholarship. Her research focused on the sustainable regeneration of former mine-owned recreation centers using the Community-based Facilities Management (CbFM) Model. She was supervised by Prof. Ephraim K. Munshifwa (Main Supervisor, CBU) and Prof. Yewande Adewunmi (Co-Supervisor, University of the Witwatersrand). The research validates the appropriateness of using the CbFM Model in portraying the value of community facilities and the importance of the social capital of a community. The findings of the research were published as two journal articles, three conference proceedings and one book chapter, thus resulting in the award of the PhD in Real Estate Studies.

### Thesis Abstract

Mining has been a key sector for the Zambian economy not just because of its contribution to the Country's Gross Domestic Product, but also in terms of social, physical and human development. Formal mining operations on the Copperbelt Province began in the early 1920s by private investors, who constructed support infrastructure like schools, hospitals and recreation centers, and offered township management services like waste management and road maintenance. In 1969, Zambia nationalised the mining sector, and in 1982 the Zambia Consolidated Copper Mines (ZCCM) was formed to manage 51% share in all the mines. In the 1990s, the mines were privatised and sold off as packages, with investors being given the option to

select which infrastructure they wanted to adopt. This choice resulted in those social facilities not adopted by the new investors being given off as trusts or to the government, and being sold off to individuals. This resulted in a management quandary and thus many are in a derelict state. This research used four previously mine-owned recreation centers in Kitwe and Mufulira, to investigate their sustainable regeneration using an exploratory mixed-method sequential design. The research argued that the regeneration of these facilities could be possible using the six impact areas of Community-based Facilities Management namely: experience, resilience, viability, accessibility, effectiveness and engagement. The research further argued that identifying key stakeholders to participate in the regeneration process, and ascertaining the social capital dimensions possessed by the communities where the recreation centers are located could achieve this. The research found that the key stakeholders to participate in the regeneration process include ward councilors', volunteers, foreign investors, and central and local government, to provide various resources, mentorship, encouragement and the policies to support the recreation industry. Also, the communities possess adequate dimensions of bonding, bridging and linking social capital, reflected in their knowledge of each other, the assistance rendered to neighbours, conflict management and the existence of various languages, religions and organisations. The research then developed a framework based on the Community-based Facilities Management Model, validated by experts from varying backgrounds.



### Godson F. ABBEY

MSc Astrophysics [UNN], Bsc Astrophysics [RSU]

**THESIS TITLE:** Investigation into the Cause of Time Lags in the Arrival Time of Photons of Different Frequencies Emanating from Gamma-ray Bursts.

**G**odson Fortune Abbey holds a Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.) degree in Astrophysics and Astronomy from Rivers State University, Port Harcourt and a Master of Science (M.Sc.) degree in Astrophysics and Space Science from the University of Nigeria, Nsukka. He was a pioneering PhD student of the Pan African Planetary and Space Science Network (PAPSSN) and is currently a postdoc fellow at the Department of Physics at Copperbelt University (CBU), Zambia under the Development in Africa with Radio Astronomy (DARA). Abbey's doctoral research was done under the supervision of Prof. G. G Nyambuya (main supervisor) of the National University of Science and Technology Bulawayo, Zimbabwe and Dr. J. Simfukwe (co-supervisor) of Copperbelt University Zambia. His research sheds new light on the underlying physical mechanisms of GRB propagation specifically, his work contributes to the ongoing quest to determine the rest mass of the photon, a fundamental constant in physics. His research culminated in multiple peer-reviewed publications in prestigious journals such as "The International Journal of Astronomy and Astrophysics (IJAA)", with several presented works at both local and international workshops and conferences, reflecting both the depth and quality of his contributions to the field.

### Thesis Abstract

This study investigates the time delays ( $\Delta t$ ) in the arrival times of photons with different frequencies from multiple Gamma-Ray Burst

(GRB) events, using a novel Linear Frequency Dependent Speed of Light (LFDSL) model developed from Maxwell's equations, dispersion effects and plasma physics. The delays are hypothesized to arise from the interaction between photons and the electrons in a rarefied cosmic plasma medium, causing dispersion and inverse frequency-dependent variations in the speed of light by the relation:  $\Delta t = K\Delta\nu^{-1}$ , as opposed to the traditional assumption of a non-zero photon mass and plasma effect which varies by the relation:  $\Delta t = K\Delta\nu^{-2}$ . Through regression analysis and model refinement, this work improves upon earlier studies by accounting for the non-simultaneous emission of photons, leading to stronger correlations between time delays and photon frequencies. By applying this model to four key GRBs namely (GRB 030329, 980425, 000418, and 021004), we derive the frequency equivalence of the interstellar medium's conductance ( $\nu \approx 1.507 \pm 0.0009$  Hz), estimate spatial dimensions of the internal and external shock wave from the GRB jets and calculate independent distance measures wherein we obtain average distances to our individual GRB events. The model's outcomes also reveal a coherent photon mass,  $m_\gamma = (1.584 \pm 0.009) \times 10^{-37}$  kg, based on the observed time delays. These findings support two GRB models—the fireball and multiple shock wave models—offering new insights into GRB jet dynamics and photon mass, providing a foundation for future studies on GRB afterglows and relativistic outflows.

**THESIS TITLE:** Investigating the Relationship between Human Resource Development and Organizational Performance: A Case of the Ministry of Education in Zambia.

**M**utale Daniel Chanda holds a Master's in Business Administration (General) and a Bachelor's Degree in Human Resource Management from The Copperbelt University (CBU), where he was recognized as the Best Graduating Student in 2016. He is a Senior Human Resource Management Officer at the Ministry of Education, Luapula Province. In 2024, Mutale completed his PhD by Research at CBU's School of Business, under the supervision of Professor Evaristo Nsenduluka (Main Supervisor), Professor Chanda Sichinsambwe (Co-supervisor), and Professor Beyani Maliti (Co-supervisor). His research, self-sponsored, explores strategies for human resource development in rapidly changing environments, emphasizing policy formulation and environmental scanning to enhance organizational performance. The study was founded on a positivist research philosophy and utilized a descriptive and cross-sectional research design. The population consisted of 1288 secondary schools and 301 respondents provided primary data using self-administered questionnaires. SPSS 23 and AMOS 26 software were used to compute descriptive statistics and structural modeling equation analysis. The findings revealed that human resource

His research provides evidence-based solutions to enhance asset allocation efficiency and improve the long-term sustainability of pension funds in dynamic financial landscapes. Macmillan's findings have been widely recognized, presented at national and international conferences, and published in reputable peer-reviewed scientific journals, contributing to global discussions on investment strategy and pension fund management.

### **Thesis Abstract**

This study endeavoured to develop an evidence-based investment strategy to support the viability of the pension fund industry in emerging economies. It aimed to determine how the financial performance of pension funds in an emerging Zambian economy can be enhanced through asset allocation and portfolio management strategies. The study was grounded in the philosophy of pragmatism and employed an explanatory sequential research design. Return on assets and balance sheet investment proportions were used as proxies for fund performance and asset allocation decisions, respectively. Annual panel data was extracted from the audited financial reports of 39 pension funds that

operated continuously between 2011 and 2020. Additionally, in-depth expert interviews were conducted with 11 fund managers. The Sharpe ratio was used to assess the statistical significance of value creation on member contributions. Panel data regression and Granger causality modelling were employed to examine the relationship between asset allocation decisions and fund performance, while content and thematic analysis were applied to the qualitative interview data. The findings revealed that the industry was underperforming in its ability to provide meaningful retirement benefits. Asset allocation decisions and portfolio management strategies emerged as significant explanatory variables for fund performance. Interviews further highlighted several constraints within the investment market that limit effective investment strategy execution. The study underscores the importance of evidence-based investment strategies for improving pension fund viability. It recommends a review of asset allocation and portfolio management practices to ensure adequate wealth creation for income replacement in retirement. Moreover, it calls on policymakers to foster a supportive regulatory and operational environment for the industry. This research contributes practical investment and policy recommendations grounded in empirical evidence. It advances understanding of asset allocation efficiency, value creation, and the investment environment required for effective pension fund management in emerging economies. Additionally, it enhances portfolio management theory within contexts characterised by unique structural and economic constraints.
